Students and teachers can step back in time to 1836 and learn the rich history for Texas Independence.

> Texas Heritage and Independence Celebration Association (THICA) is hosting the event where attendees will have a hands-on experience in viewing life as it was back in 1836. A historic campsite will be setup, with Tejano, Texian and Mexican soldiers sharing the history and culture of that era, and telling the legendary story of Texas' Independence. The reenactments performed on April 13 and 14 for Happy Birthday TexasFest are representations of three key battles of Texas' fight for independence from Mexico in 1835-1836.

> > The soldiers' camp will include a section for camp followers (women and children) who will be demonstrating sewing, cooking, caring for medical injuries and even laundry techniques used during that time period. Observers will be able to interact with the reeanactors and talks on Tejano service in Texas will be presented. Come by and take a step back in time and enjoy a moment in history.
